Our Regattas:

The rowing club hosted the Early Bird Regatta, Mother's Day Regatta, and The SCRC Invitational Regatta. These regattas were successful due to the many volunteers who unselfishly shared their time and skills.

2017 Racing Season: (See Appendix I for a full list of regattas)

Crews were able to take advantage of a fairly long rowing season. Boats were on the water in April/March of 2017 and rowing continued right into mid-December. Our athletes competed in over 30 regattas and events throughout the racing season.

The competitive season for Masters, Open Competitive and Secondary School Athletes began with indoor rowing events. Our members competed in the Canadian and Ontario Indoor Championships. Once on the water, Secondary schools took part in a number of regattas locally (e.g., Mother's Day), nationally (e.g., CSSRA), and internationally (e.g., Stotesbury).

During the summer competitive season, we had outstanding results at local, provincial and national regattas (see Highlights and Appendix I). The culmination of this season was the Canadian Henley Masters regatta and Canadian Henley. We had strong results at both regattas with multiple Henley Gold medals. The club won the Efficiency Trophy at Canadian Henley and had a top 10 finish at Canadian Henley Masters.

During the fall, we had very good results at the Head of the Welland, the Head of the Charles and the Head of the Fish in both the Masters and Open divisions. SCRC athletes also competed in the National Rowing Championships in Burnaby, BC.

SCRC athletes and coaches competed at the National and International level. We had representation at the 2017 Canada Summer Games (CSG) in Winnipeg, MB; the CanAmMex Regatta, at Elk Lake, BC; the U23 World Championships in Plovdiv, BUL; and the Senior World Championships in Sarasota-Bradenton, USA. Many of these athletes returned to compete successfully at Canadian Henley.
